Human-research-protection education	Completed the five-part HHS Office for Human Research Protections Human Research Protection Training sequence on June 11, 2026. Additional CITI, sponsor, institutional, or IRB-specific training will be completed if required.
Current research status	Study enrollment is not open. The independent human-research-protection or IRB pathway, final research-data custody, and the production study system must be finalized before participant research begins.

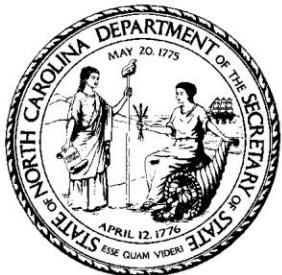
